# Messages to Women

## We Will Rise



As we look at the past two years in review, we can say that we have literally gone through unchartered waters. We function in a world that is full of uncertainty and turbulence and we need to become more than ever before, discipled in the Word to become hopeful if we are to overcome challenges.

Ezekiel, Chapter 47 of the river that flows from the Temple. This portion of scripture carries so much of hope that inspires us to believe and rise again. We establish that firstly, it is a vision of the future temple. The image of the water is a reflection of the Holy Spirit and the presence of God. Perhaps we have ventured as far as the entrance of our churches, but we have not gone past the gates. The time has come for us to arise and return to our places of worship.

We cannot remain in the past neither can we remain stagnant. We have got to arise and get into the flow! and stay in flow! (..... and he caused me to pass through the waters (Amplified Classic v 3). Open up your mind and Spirit and allow the refreshing waters to embrace you and take you deeper.

As we open up our eyes to the Word we see that "breakthroughs" followed after being "brought through" the water. It was only after coming through the water that the Prophet saw the freshness, fruitfulness, healing, the plenty and the abundance. (And wherever the double river shall go, every living creature which swam shall live.)

Just like the "woman at the well", Jesus is extending an invitation to us to drink from these living waters. Jesus did not ask the woman to toil and "draw" the water but rather "to drink" for it was readily and freely available. I trust that each one of us will reply as the woman did "15 The woman said to him, "Sir, give me this water so that I won't get thirsty and have to keep coming here to draw water."






